1.International Business (English Instruction)

This major is designed to help students develop a good understanding of the basic theories, fundamentals and relevant skills of international business, as well as international conventions and rules in international business. It also equips students with good communicating skills with which graduates of this major are able to analyze and solve problems in business management and are qualified to participate directly in the international competition and cooperation as well as perform roles in international business, government agencies, trade enterprises and cultural exchanges departments.

Core courses: Microeconomics, Macroeconomics, Management Principles, International Marketing, Accounting Principles, International Business Law, Financial Management, Human Resource Management, International Finance, Organization Behavior Science, etc.

2.International Economics and Trade (English Instruction)

Undergraduate Program: Chinese Language

The duration of these programs is 4 years. Courses in the first two academic years give students a solid foundation in the basics of the Chinese language. In the third and fourth years, special module courses are offered. Students who have already passed the new HSK5 as well as the placement test of Institute for International Education could choose any of the following module and start directly from grade 3; Students who have passed the new HSK4 could start directly from grade 2 while beginners of Chinese language learning will start from grade 1.

1. Chinese Language (Business Chinese)

This program aims at training high-level international trade professionals by giving them a solid foundation in Chinese language and a systematic mastery of international trade theory. The conventions and regulations of international trade as well as an overview of the current situation in China are also incorporated into the study. Graduates are expected to be competent in international business work by using fluent Chinese.

Core Courses: Comprehensive Business Chinese, Business Chinese Listening and Speaking, Business Chinese Writing, Economic News Reader, International Trade Practices, International Economic Law, Contemporary Chinese Economy, International Trade in China, Marketing, China Overview.

2. Chinese Language (International Logistics)

This program aims at training high-level international trade professionals by giving them a solid foundation in Chinese language and proficiency in listening, speaking, reading and writing Chinese as well as a systematic mastery of basic theories of modern logistics and international trade. The basic skills of international logistics are also incorporated into the study. Graduates are expected to be competent in using Chinese in business work.

4. Chinese Language (Tourism and Culture)

Visa

Once get qualified, candidates may get the letter of admission and JW201 form we prepare for you within 30 to 45 days(the period may be extended during winter/summer holidays and Chinese public holidays). Candidates can get the letter of admission and JW201 form themselves here at school, or entrust the agents or international express companies to do so on their behalf. With these two documents and your passport, you can apply for your 'X' visa at the Chinese Embassy/Consulate in your country. The international students with 'X1' visa must apply for a Residence Permit within 30 days after your arrival in China.

Accommodation and Dining

North campus: All dormitories are equipped with a private restroom, a shower room, internet access and an air conditioner. Shared laundries and kitchens re available on each floor

Double room: 4800RMB/semester/bed(or 1250RMB/month/bed); Quad-room: 2400RMB/semester/bed(650RMB/month/bed).

Note: Each international student is provided with a certain amount of water and electricity, once exceeded, the exceeding part should be paid yourself.

Bedding is not provided.

South campus: All dormitories are equipped with a balcony, a restroom, an air conditioner, a telephone, internet access and hot shower. Shared laundries are also available.
