- Guangzhou, surrounded by a kaleidoscope of flowers, is honored as an "International Garden City" by the United Nations for its picturesque natural environment, high-quality air, mild and humid climate all the year round.
- Guangzhou, an international hub, is with convenient transportation, as it is adjacent to Hong Kong and Macao and close to Southeast Asia.
- Guangzhou, the cultural center in South China, boasts perfect supporting facilities in terms of landmark cultural venues, namely, Guangzhou Grand Theater, various museums, concert halls, and art galleries. The Canton Tower is the tallest tower in China.
- Guangzhou, the birthplace of Cantonese cuisine (one of eight major Chinese cuisines), is famous for its fine food. Crowded with innumerable tea houses and distinct food culture, it enables visitors to enjoy global cuisines and experience one-stop shopping without leaving the city.

# 02 Why GDUFS

Featured with distinctive international characteristics and abundant international resources, Guangdong University of Foreign Studies (GDUFS) is one of the first universities in China to accept international students, who will be accessible to diverse courses and numerous internship opportunities against the backdrop of powerful faculty and professional management team.

- Distinctive International Characteristics. As of now, GDUFS opens 31 foreign language programs, the most of its kind in South China, and has established cooperative and exchange relationships with 486 overseas universities from 60 countries. GDUFS now has 7 overseas Confucius Institutes (Classrooms). It has been receiving international students since 1986, with thousands of international students from over a hundred countries and regions studying here every year.
- Professional Faculty. GDUFS is one of the first universities obtaining qualification of teaching Chinese as a foreign language in China. The Institute for International Education (IIE) is responsible for the enrollment of international students, teaching Chinese as a foreign language, part of the course teaching in English, and the management of international students. All faculties are at the forefront of international education as they have studied or worked overseas before.
- Helpful Multi-lingual Management & Services. The multi-lingual management team of IIE offers students with professional management and services, namely, enrollment consultation, visa management, academic affairs management, extracurricular activity organization, student management and services, aiming to cultivate superior international students.
- Abundant Student Activities and Rich Internship Opportunities. IIE regularly holds characteristic student activities such as the World Culture Festival, Perception of China, and Chinese Carnival every year. It also collaborates with well-known enterprises and institutions such as the Guangdong Import and Export Chamber of Commerce, Guangdong ETR Law Firm, Guangzhou Arbitration Commission, and NetEase Youdao to establish an innovative practice and internship base for international students, apart from hiring off campus vocational mentors.
- Advantageous Campus Environment. There are four campuses under GDUFS. Baiyun Mountain campus, which is the main campus, is located at the north foot of Baiyunshan, Guangzhou, adjacent to Baiyun National Forest Park. It is a fully functional campus well equipped with library, international student apartments and sports center, making campus life safe, friendly, and convenient.

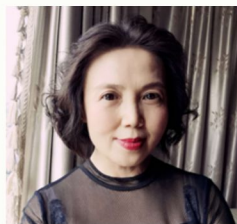

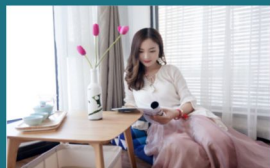

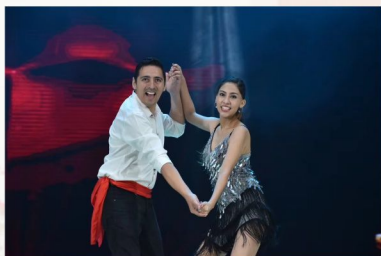

# 08 Applications

## I. Basic requirements:

1. Non-Chinese nationality, holding a foreign passport, and meeting the relevant requirements of the "Jiao Wai Han [2020] No. 12".
2. Physical and mental health, meeting the medical examination standards set by the Chinese government and meeting the requirements for applying for a study visa or residence permit in China.
3. Abide by Chinese laws and regulations as well as school rules and regulations, be diligent and eager to learn, achieve excellent results, and have a good character; no records of violating school rules and discipline, no public security penalties, and no criminal records.
4. Education and language proficiency meet the requirements of the applied major.
5. If there is a need to apply for a scholarship, applicants for a bachelor's degree are generally no more than 30 years old (Chinese government scholarship bachelor applicants are no more than 25 years old); Applicants for a master's degree generally do not exceed the age of 35; Applicants for a doctoral degree are generally under the age of 40.
6. Comply with other relevant legal and regulatory requirements.
