Prospectus of Chinese Language Programme for International Students

Guangzhou—International Trading Center

Guangzhou is the capital city of Guangdong Province and the largest business center in China. Guangzhou has long enjoyed the fame as the renowned historic and cultural centre, the exciting economic hub of the country and is often referred to as "the Southern Gate of China".

Guangzhou is

- A subtropical, coastal city enjoying a temperate climate throughout the year. Flowers blossom year round, giving the area the name "the City of Flowers".
- •The city is a transportation hub boasting a highly-developed and convenient transportation network, connecting major cities around the world, and only 2 hours' drive from Hong Kong and Macau.
- •Guangzhou is the forefront of China's Reform and Opening-up with its GDP volume ranking No. 1 in the country as a whole. One-third of the Fortune 500 corporations have set up branches in this city.
- •As the birthplace of Maritime Silk Road in China, Guangzhou has grown into a metropolis which holds the "China Import & Export Commodity Trade Fair" twice a year, the biggest trade fair of its kind in China, to attract customers from worldwide to procure commodities here.

Guangdong University of Foreign Studies—A Major Internationalized University

Guangdong University of Foreign Studies (GDUFS) is embraced by Baiyun Mountain, with the north campus enjoying a beautiful environment of marvelous green hills, making itself an ideal place for academic studies and learning. GDUFS is a major internationalized university in South China for its global-minded faculty/students and its research on international languages, literature, culture, trade and strategic studies. As home to two provincial-level collaborative innovation centers, GDUFS is one of the few universities worldwide qualified to provide high-end translation professionals to the United Nations, China's only foreign studies-oriented university that is in the CAMPUS ASIA program and that is accredited by the Association of MBAs (AMBA), and also home to the Secretariat of the Asian University Presidents' Forum (AUPF). GDUFS offers 72 undergraduate programs in literature, economics, management, law, engineering, science, education and art for bachelor, master and doctoral degrees and post-doctoral research. With 26 foreign languages available, the University is the only one in South China that boasts the greatest variety of foreign language programs.

About Institute for International Education (IIE)—A Model Base for Studying in China

The university was accredited as one of the earliest universities to teach Chinese for non-Chinese speakers. Therefore, IIE has long been responsible for international students enrollment, teaching and administration. In 2016, the universities have received 2,707 international students from over 123 countries and regions.

Chinese Language Programs

1. Long-Term/Short-Term Chinese Language Training Programs

Introductory, Elementary, Intermediate and Advanced Level.

Applications are accepted throughout the year. Elementary and above-level students are eligible for immediate enrollment. Flexible term arrangements are available to meet individual needs: Length of study may include 4 weeks, 8 weeks, half year, 1 year and/or up to two years.

Tuition fee: RMB 17200 / per year, RMB 8600 / per term, RMB 4700 / 8 weeks

Application fee: RMB500

2. Intensive Chinese Training Programs (for winter and summer vacations)

These 4-week programs begin in January and July each year. Participants at the Introductory, Elementary and Intermediate levels can take intensive courses in Communicative Chinese under respective program frameworks.

Tuition fee: RMB2600, Application fee: RMB300



3. Short-Term Study Tour Programs

These programs are tailor-made featuring Chinese language training courses, Lectures in foreign languages, students' dialogue, Chinese culture activities, sight-seeing and field trips to companies and government institutions. All are offered to help international students obtain a deeper understanding of Guangzhou City, and China as a whole, and to enhance their intercultural communication abilities and international perspectives within a short time span. Fees are to be negotiated upon the program schedule.

Admission Requirements

International students in good mental and physical conditions with legal visa are welcome to apply to study with us. Please note that for students who conceal their unsatisfactory health conditions which give rise to a disease thus making the student cannot conduct his or her study but to quit schooling, and for students cannot get a visa to study in China, under the above mentioned circumstances, the paid tuition is not refundable.

Insurance

It is mandatory that all international students must pay for Comprehensive Medical Insurance & Protection Scheme for Foreigners Staying in China of Ping An Annuity Insurance Co., Ltd.

International Student Dormitory

Balconied double and quad rooms (equipped with private toilet/bath, hot water supply, air-conditioning, and internet connections. A separate Public kitchen, laundry facilities, a refrigerator, kitchenware, table, washing machine and drying machine are on every floor) are available in the international residence building on the North Campus.

Cost: RMB2400/ semester/ bed for a four person's room and RMB 4800/ semester/ bed for a double room. cost includes internet, water and electricity. Students need to pay for extra fees for hot water shower.

Please note that the on-campus dormitory has very limited rooms, students must confirm their application via email with IIE.
